We specialise in termination of pregnancy for patients up to 16 weeks gestation. For pregnancies outside this period, specialist advice and services are provided.

We have a variety of contraceptive options offering the choice for sedation.

- Intrauterine Devices (IUD)
- Multiload IUD
- IUD Mirena
- Implanon
- Depo Provera

Our sedation options are performed by our highly skilled anaesthetist, making your appointment as pleasant as possible.

Preparing For an Appointment

Upon making an appointment, our staff will ask a series of questions designed to make your time with us as smooth as possible. If you are on medication, let us know at the time of booking.

Before you arrive:

Have nothing to eat, drink or smoke 6 hours prior to your appointment. (This includes drinking water while brushing your teeth.)

Don't chew gum or suck on any lollies before your visit. Shower and shampoo your hair on the morning of your appointment.

What to Bring:

One person to bring you to and from the clinic (No children or infants please). Due to strict medical restrictions you cannot drive home.

Personal ID i.e. Drivers Licence, Passport or two credit/bank cards.

Your medicare card and any relevant concession card.

Clinic fee (if paying by cash, please have the correct amount.) Eftpos is available. All cards are accepted.

Any ultrasound, doctor referral/s and medical reports. Any medication you are taking (including inhalers, or insulin)

Comfortable clothes

NO tight jeans, G-string, panty hose or body suits.

A clean set of underwear

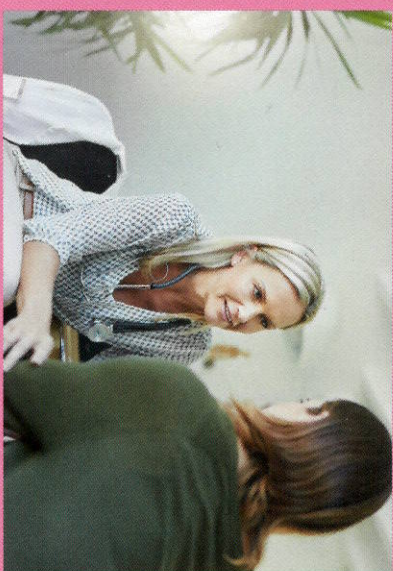
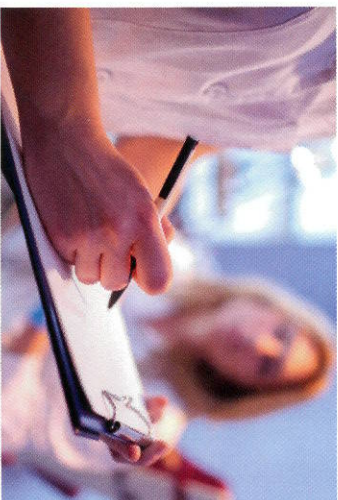
Two Adhesive Sanitary napkins/pads.

Tea/ coffee/ water / biscuits is available in recovery after your procedure on request.

**Patients who are not permanent residents of Australia, holding temporary medicare cards will have to pay the full amount. An itemised receipt will be provided.

Do not bring valuables to the clinic

Babies or children are not permitted in the clinic.



On arrival you will be required to complete administration information forms giving your details and medical history.

You will have a consultation with the surgeon and the anaesthetist who can address any of your concerns or questions.

Printed postoperative instructions will be given to you.

We will contact your lift home an hour before you are due to leave the clinic.

Your stay at the clinic will be between 3-6 hours, depending on the stage of your pregnancy.

Frequently Asked Questions

"How much does it cost?"

The cost depends on the gestation of your pregnancy, i.e. how many weeks you are pregnant. When you contact the clinic we give you the details of the costs involved.

"What if I do not have medicare?"

Unfortunately, we have to charge you the full amount for any service we provide. If you have overseas private cover, we can give you an itemised account to take to your fund as you may be able to claim money back.

"Do I need a referral from a doctor?"

No you do not need a referral. However if you have a referral we would like you to bring it with you on the day of your appointment.

The team here at GSDS are very supportive and uplifting to all of our patients and we will strive to help you through your process as best we can. As a renowned women's healthcare clinic, we are very independently unique from a hospital or your general doctors surgery and work closely with all our staff to ensure a safe and helpful experience.

Greenslopes Day Surgery is now operating out of Brisbane Day Hospital for a wide range of medical procedures.

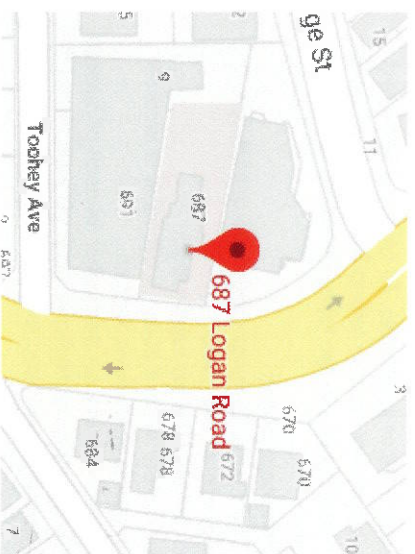
